

POLLUTION ORDINANCE

An ordinance enacted by the Village of Northport, Michigan in the interest of the Public Health, to prevent the contamination and pollution of streams, ponds or any other body of water or watercourse within the corporate limits of the Village of Northport, Michigan.

The Village of Northport, Michigan enacts:

"No person shall discharge or permit to be discharged into the harbor or into any watercourse within the corporate limits any industrial waste, garbage, untreated sewage, refuse, ashes, cherries, cherry pits, oil, fruits, fruit juices, animal substances, mineral substances, vegetable substances, shavings, saw-dust, or other waste material.

Neither shall there be any tile fields, dry wells, septic tanks, seepage pits, cesspools, outdoor toilets, privies within twenty-five (25) feet of any watercourse.

This ordinance shall be in force twenty days (20) from the date of passage of same.

Penalty for failure to comply with this ordinance shall be a fine of \$100.00 or thirty days in prison or both.
