

AN ORDINANCE TO REGULATE THE USE AND POSSESSION OF FIREARMS AND OTHER DANGEROUS INSTRUMENTALITIES WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE VILLAGE OF NORTHPORT: TO PROVIDE PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS, AND TO REPEAL ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH.

THE VILLAGE OF NORTHPORT ORDAINS:

Section 1.

That it shall be unlawful for any person or persons to discharge any fire-arm, air rifle, bow and arrow or sling shot within the corporate limits of the Village of Northport, Michigan, without first obtaining authorization from the Village Council or its duly appointed officer or representative.

Section 2.

That it shall be unlawful for any minor under the age of 17 years to be in possession of any fire-arm, air rifle, bow and arrow or sling shot on any public street or building within the corporate limits of the Village of Northport.

Section 3.

Any person found to be violating any provision of this ordinance shall be, upon conviction thereof before a court of competent jurisdiction, punished by the confiscation of said fire-arm, air rifle, bow and arrow or sling shot, by a fine of not more than Twenty-five (\$25) Dollars or by imprisonment in the County jail for not more than 10 days or by such confiscation, fine and imprisonment in the discretion of the court trying the offender.

Section 4.

This ordinance repeals all ordinances and parts of ordinances inconsistent or in conflict herewith.

Section 5.

This ordinance and the various parts, sections and clauses hereof are hereby declared to be separable. If any part, section or clause is ad-

judged unconstitutional or invalid, it is intended that the balance of the ordinance shall not be affected thereby.

Section 6.

This ordinance shall take effect on the 17 day of April, 1958.
