Ordinance # 66

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE ADDITION OF FLURIDE TO WATER SUPPLIED
TO THE PUBLIC BY THE VILLAGE OF NORTHPORT

THE VILLAGE OF NORTHPORT ORDAINS:

That water supplied to the public by the Village of Northport, or water which is supplied to the public under the direction of the Village of Northport, shall not be treated by the addition of fluoride, the addition of fluoride being herewith rejected by said Village.

This Ordinance is made pursuant to the provisions of Act No. 346 of the Public Acts of 1968, as amended, of the State of Michigan.

This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from after thirty (30) days after the date of its adoption and approval.
