

VILLAGE ORDINANCE

No. 70

ADOPTED: JUNE 17, 1976

EFFECTIVE: JULY 7, 1976

THE VILLAGE OF NORTHPORT ORDAINS:

Section 1. No person shall occupy a mobile home, motor home, trailer coach, trailer, tent trailer, camper, tent, or other structure or motor vehicle designed for and so constructed as to permit sleeping space by one or more persons upon the highways, alleys, beaches, public parks, playgrounds, ponds and other public places within the Village of Northport, except in a regularly designated camping area operated by or with the approval of the Village of Northport

Section 2. No person shall set up tents, shacks or any other temporary shelter or allow a mobile home, motor home, trailer coach, trailer, tent trailer, camper, tent, or other structure or motor vehicle designed for and so constructed as to permit sleeping space by one or more persons upon the highway, alleys, beaches, public parks, playgrounds, ponds and other public places within the Village of Northport, except in a regularly designated camping area operated by or with the approval of the Village of Northport

Section 3. Mobile home, motor home, trailer coach, trailer, tent trailer, camper, or tent shall be defined to include, but not be limited to, any vehicle with or without motive power, designed for carrying property or persons and so constructed as to permit occupancy as a dwelling or sleeping space by one or more persons, or any vehicle with motive power designed permanently for living or sleeping, or used to carry a unit so designed.

Section 4. Any person violating any provisions of this ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor punishable by a fine not exceeding \$100.00 and in default in the payment thereof, to imprisonment for a period not exceeding 90 days, or both.

Section 5. This ordinance shall become effective 30 days after its adoption.

ORDINANCE DECLARED ADOPTED

(i) Exercise and perform all administrative functions that are not imposed by charter upon some other official;

(j) Present to the Council periodic reports and special reports when requested by the Council covering the activities of the Village administration for which he is responsible;

(k) Recommend to the Council the salaries to be paid each appointive officer and employee of the village under his jurisdiction;

(l) Perform such other duties as may be required of him from time to time by the Council, not inconsistent with the charter of the village, or with statute or ordinances.

SECTION VI: Neither the Council nor the Village President, nor any of the members or committees of the Council shall dictate the recommendations of the Administrator as to the appointment of any person to office or to the employment of any person by the Village Administrator, or in any way interfere with the Administrator to prevent him from exercising his judgement therein or in the direction of the departments under his jurisdiction. Except for the purpose of inquiry, the President and the Council and its members shall deal with the departments under the jurisdiction of the Administrator through the Administrator.

SECTION VII: If any portion of this ordinance or the application thereof to any person or circumstances shall be found to be invalid by a court, such invalidity shall not affect the remaining portions or applications of the ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid portion or applications, provided that such remaining portions or applications are not determined by said court to be inoperable, and to this end this ordinance is declared to be severable.

SECTION VIII: This ordinance shall take issued effect on date of passage thereof; January 20, 1977
