Discussion Items:

1. Update on Status of marina electrical work: we are one day from having the necessary facts and figures from Advantage Electric.
2. The "Orange Reservoir" needs replacing. A quote is forthcoming from Oscar Larson. This needs to be an Action Item at the next Council meeting.
3. Golf cart parking: people assume that since Haserot Park has been opened to golf carts that this is true for the Marina Park and South Beach as well. There is a need for signs prohibiting golf carts from parking in both the Marina Park and South Beach Park.
4. Security Cameras need to be installed at the Marina and the marina parking lot and all bathroom areas. There have been enough incidents this summer and in the past to warrant this being done. Also an Action Item?
5. The goose problem seems to have abated in the last 10 days. Hopefully they are gone for this year.
6. The Council should discuss establishing the jurisdictional boundaries for the Harbormaster. The question was raised by Mr. Harper as to whether or not those boundaries include the parks adjacent to the marina.

Public Comment: Mr. Richards stated there is a need for 12 more floats at the South Beach swim area to complete the circle of safety for swimmers. He also stated that additional white floats are needed to keep boats away from the swim area. There has been a problem with boats getting too close for safety this summer.
