#### Discussion/Action Items

1. Discussion regarding the opening date for the marina with options being May 15, May 28, and June 10 (which is the date for the opening of the state harbors).
2. Discussion about the services that can be offered in light of the high water/Coronavirus issues.
3. Discussion on what services will be made available for transients. It was suggested that the boater's bathroom be available for slip holders only. It was also suggested that pump outs be made available for transients at reduced or no cost.
4. It was suggested that fuel and pump outs begin no sooner than June 10 and that date is subject to change. There was discussion about turning on the water and electric for slip holders on May 15 but that was not finalized.
5. There was much concern over protecting the boaters with regard to the COVID-19 pandemic. There will need to be shower/laundry schedules (sign-up sheets) posted and limited to slip holders only...NO guests or transients.
6. Disinfecting common areas will need to be attended to by staff. Disinfectant spray bottles could be made available in the showers for the boaters to use after using the facility
7. Discussion regarding providing a handwashing station to be located on the boardwalk.

8. Discussion about hiring dock hands on a limited basis until we know more about what will be available in terms of services in the marina.
9. Discussion regarding having a special Village Council meeting to approve many of the discussion items listed above.
