Discussion/ Action items:

- A. Marina Operations: The general state of the park grounds between the parking lots encompassing the Pavilion was discussed. There have been complaints regarding the shabby appearance of late. It was suggested that the Harbormaster speak with the head of the DPW to coordinate lawn maintenance. Some of the dock hands are leaving for school. There are 2-3 former dock hands willing to come back part-time to take up the slack, especially on weekends. It was established that the marina will go to half-rate on Labor Day Monday (September 7th) to be in line with most other area marinas.
- B. We are still waiting for the State of Michigan to return our paperwork so that the Marina project can begin. Many State employees are on furlough delaying the process.
- C. The subject of a Marina Short Term Rental was discussed and centered on a local person's request to allow a 60' boat to be used as an AirBnB. It was suggested that the Committee set forth the rules and regulations for this type of enterprise to be presented to the Council for approval sometime in the Spring of 2021.
