**XC Ski Trails** – The group shared community feedback they'd received about the ski trail on the golf course. A tremendous amount of support was voiced. More discussion on improving and adding to winter services at the Clubhouse.

**Bike Trail** – McCann update the committee that he'd been put in contact with Kristian Saile, who has experience building bike trail/flow track in the Marquette area. Learned he had talks with Ben Purdy last year about bike trails at Bramen Hill. McCann will follow up and continue to update.

**Trailhead Sign** – The placement of trailhead signs was discussed with the new budget approved. Look at quotes for at least two sign in March. Ager brought up improving the trail map signs in town. She mentioned the sign for the lighthouse and state park located near the hardware store. The idea for a Village Kiosk was mentioned and Wetherbee noted he still had design plans for one.

**Recreational Improvements** – Clerk Scott mentioned looking at updating some of playground equipment at South Beach. Specifically the wooden structure, which is nearly 30 years old. The Lighthouse just had major overhaul of their equipment. Grants could be available. The group brainstormed other activities that could be more cost effective; Shuffleboard, Horseshoes, and tetherball. Coordinate with Waterfront committee in upcoming weeks.
