Infrastructure Meeting Minutes
April 21, 2021
1:30pm

The meeting was called to order at 1:30pm.

There was no public comment.

We received an update on the sidewalk repairs in front of the Bohemian Café. The repairs have been put on hold pending possible change of ownership of the building. This will not effect the ADA ramp. While talking about sidewalks, President Wetherbee brought up discussion of the sidewalks in front of the churches on Nagonaba Street. Although he walked the sidewalks and didn't notice anything wrong, Chris Holton will check them out.

We received an update on the street lights from President Wetherbee. He and Chris have a list of about 7 to 9 lights that they would like to have turned off, most being the cable strung lights. These lights will be removed eventually anyway.

We talked about the East Fourth Street ditch cleanup. Chris reported that he had talked to Steve Christianson. Mr. Christianson wanted to know if we had flow to the lake. Chris assured him we did. Per the County, all we have to do is to maintain flow!

We had a discussion about seal coating the Marina parking lot, the Village parking lot, and the Village roads. The Harbormaster has received quotes to patch and seal the marina parking lot. The committee, by consensus, is recommending to the council to go with Ace Seal Rite to do the marina work. Chris is having trouble getting a hold of Molon to get a price on the Village roads.

We received a report from the DPW.

We received a report from the Planning Commission.

The second public comment, we heard from Fred Steffens. He was surprised about our discussion of the Fourth St. ditch. He feels the culvert is plugged. He was hoping for something more productive than just maintaining flow. The DPW will try to unplug the culvert. We also heard from Jane Gale who reported that the Dark Sky Committee would be meeting on the 3rd of May and she would inform them of our discussion on the streetlights.

A motion to adjourn was made by President Wetherbee and seconded by Harper. By a roll call vote Wetherbee (yes), Harper (yes), and Cook (yes), the meeting was adjourned at 2:39pm.
