

VILLAGE OF NORTHPORT
ORDINANCE NO. 108, 2015

AN ORDINANCE TO REPEAL ORDINANCE NO. 89

The Village of Northport ordains:

SECTION 1: PURPOSE

The purpose of the ordinance is to repeal Ordinance no. 89, Public Road Ends

SECTION 2: INTENT

The intent of the ordinance is to allow for the county sheriff's department to enforce the road ends in the Village of Northport according to the posted signage.

SECTION 3: EFFECTIVE DATE

This Ordinance shall take effect upon the date of its publication.

SECTION 4: ADOPTION

The Ordinance must be adopted by an affirmative vote of a majority of the members of the Village Council.

SECTION 5: RECORD OF ORDINANCE:


Upon enactment, this Ordinance shall be added to the Village Record of Ordinances and the President and Clerk shall authenticate the Ordinance by placing their signatures upon the Ordinance.

SECTION 6: PUBLICATION:

Within 15 days after the Ordinance is passed, the Village Clerk shall publish the Ordinance in the *Leelanau Enterprise*. Immediately after publication, the Clerk

shall enter into the Record of Ordinances a signed certificate stating the date on which and the name of the newspaper in which the Ordinance was published.


