ACTION/DISCUSSION ITEMS:

1. Harbormaster report: All Broadside posts have been replaced. There are about 20 dock posts that need replacing. Beginning to pull the waiting lists together – there are several on the 60' list that have not responded. Dockhand numbers are changing. Two have left for the year and one more is on vacation with his family. Of the 12 dockhands this summer, 9 will be returning. Marina traffic is way down this week for the first time all summer. Marina hours will change to 8 – 6 for now except for weekends (8 – 8) if they are busy. The marina really needs to have dedicated shopper's slips. Some people abuse the 3 loads of laundry rule. Laundry prices need to be adjusted next year – coin machines? All area harbormasters agree this has been the busiest boating season ever. Our harbor was at or near 100% capacity every day from the week before July 4<sup>th</sup> until last week. It would be helpful to standardize our garbage cans so one size garbage bag could be ordered...as of now there are 8 different types in use.
2. There is a long list of topics that will be discussed regarding marina operations once the season is over. We will have the winter months to find solutions to problems such as bathroom cleaning, tallying daily receipts, dockhand hiring/pay, security camera operation, and more.
