Public comments: Laura Cavendish asked about the status of the sidewalk in front of the New Bohemian Café and the rest of the sidewalk on Waukazoo Street. She was also wondering if the parking lot lines would be repainted this year.

Chris gave an update on the new Salt Barn. They are waiting for the paving of the base before they can start.

Cindy gave us an update on Streetlights. The lights they selected have been turned off. We have received a few complaints about some of the lights that have been turned off. We also dissolved the street light committee.

We received an update on the 7th street building. They are waiting for Consumers Power to disconnect the power (should be this week). Once the building is removed, the DPW will remove the concrete floor. They will then fill with sand and put topsoil over and plant seed.
