DISCUSSION/ACTION ITEMS:

1. Mr. Harper asked about a report that someone from EGLE had contacted the Village concerning the painting project at the G. Marsten Dame Marina. President Wetherbee confirmed that he had a conversation with a person from EGLE that was cordial and informative. Mr. Wetherbee explained the nature of the work and what procedures were followed to mitigate any water contamination. The end result was that EGLE is going to send a form to the Village to be completed and returned to EGLE.
2. Harbormaster's Report: Mr. Rosemurgy commented that this last month was long and lonely compared to the hustle and bustle of the now ended boating season. He has been very busy taking care of end of season chores and putting the marina on hold for the coming winter. He will be overseeing Oscar Larson tomorrow who will be shutting down and winterizing the fuel delivery system. He has completed all of the necessary DNR reports for the past season. Bill has spent some time organizing the seasonal slip assignments including a better grouping of transient slips and shopper's slips.
3. The Waterfront Committee had an end-of-season walk through the marina led by Harbormaster Rosemurgy. Bill had put together an impressive and well-organized list of things for the Committee to see. The many issues

that will need attention include the floors in the public bathrooms, loose and rotting posts throughout the marina, new and needed signage, new methods for handling trash (lockable dumpsters), and various other maintenance issues. Mr. Cook mentioned that all flammables should be kept in an appropriate metal cabinet so one will need to be purchased for the M1 storeroom.

PUBLIC COMMENT: Campbell McCloud joined the meeting late and had a question regarding the inquiry from EGLE regarding the painting project in the marina.

ADJOURNMENT: A motion to adjourn was made by Mr. Harper and supported by Mr. Cook. YEAS 3 NAYS 0
