AGENDA:

1. Pat Machin, Engineer, gave a presentation of the probable costs for replacement of the north marina parking lot, including a rebuild of the deteriorating launch ramp. This project will likely begin in the Fall of 2022 and finish in the Spring of 2023. Once final figures are in hand the Council will need to approve and a Waterways grant will be sought after to help pay the costs.
2. Harbormaster's Report: Mr. Rosemurgy is putting a list of estimates of projects together to be included in the upcoming 2022 budget. He has made some changes in the Seasonal Slip Contracts that will make the contract more complete addressing insurance coverage and establishing a fee for late payment of slip fees. Bill is in conversation with KAM Marine and will be updating our 30-year-old contract with them. There have been no changes or updates in that time.
3. Jake Riley from the Cadillac District Office of the Water Resources Division and President Wetherbee have been trying to contact each other regarding the painting project in the Marina. It looks like they will connect today and we await a report on their conversation.
4. The Committee reviewed the suggested changes in the Seasonal Slip Agreement and approved those changes.
5. There was a brief mention of possible items to be included in the 2022 Budget. There will be more in-depth marina budget discussions next month.
