President Wetherbee gave us an update on the street lights. Consumers Power was turning lights back on today!! Steve also reported that Consumers has more details on replacement lighting. They will not be replacing bulbs, but replacing sensors that control the dimming of lights. DPW will have an app on their phone that can control this. Consumers will be turning back on 10 to 15 units.

Chris gave us an update on the Flees Road Sewer project. The sight survey has been completed and we were informed that the road is a 66 foot right of way. The big problem will be the de-watering when they start and this will affect the cost of the project. Chris has also been in contact with the Boatyard about their concerns of being able to get boats from their storage units to the boatyard.

Chris gave us a report on frozen Village water service lines. They have had problems with about 6 residential lines being frozen.

President Wetherbee gave us a report on the revised RFP's for the Fourth St. drainage problem. The draft copy is ready to go and will be sent to the Council and the residents on Fourth St. for review.
