

## Infrastructure Committee Meeting

April 20, 2022

1:30 P.M.

Roll Call: Trustee Harper and President Wetherbee were joined by DPW representative Dave Tompkins (Infrastructure Chair Cook was attending another meeting).

It was reported that Consumers Energy had started installing shields on a few of the LED street lamps in Northport. Preliminary response was favorable, but the most of the shields had yet to be installed.

Dave Tompkins presented possible changes in Northport's water rates. A final proposed rate schedule will be created at the next Committee meeting.

To date the Village has received only one response to our RFP for work on the East 4th Street drain. That response, by F & V, was a statement that they did not currently have staff available for this project.

Laura Cavendish proposed the creation of two A-frame signs to direct visitors to public restrooms and parking. The possibility of including a map showing business locations was also discussed. The idea was generally supported by the Committee and, as a next step, Laura offered to create a specific proposal for the signs.

It was reported that we now have prints for the Rose Street culvert. The DPW will continue planning for the culvert's eventual replacement.

The Committee supports hiring a new DPW member to fill the upcoming staff opening.
