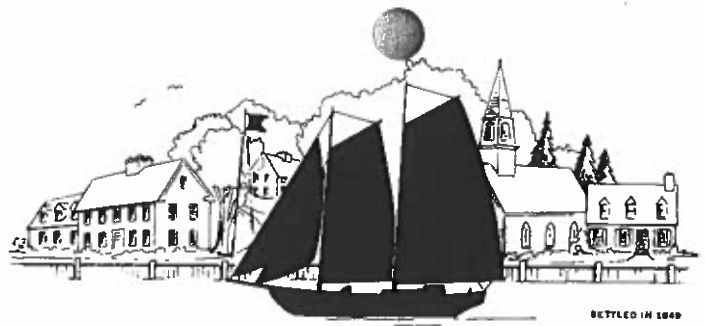

VILLAGE OF NORTHPORT ORDINANCE NUMBER 85

AN ORDINANCE TO REGULATE AND ESTABLISH HOURS OF PERMITTED USE FOR VILLAGE RECREATIONAL FACILITIES KNOWN AS HASEROT PARK AND THE NORTHPORT PUBLIC BATHING BEACH.

THE VILLAGE OF NORTHPORT ORDAINS:

Section 1.

No person firm or corporation shall be within the boundaries of the parks known as Haserot Park and the Northport Public Bathing Beach between Midnight and Sunrise.

Section 2. Description/Definition

When used herein, word "Haserot Park" will include the following boundaries: "Lots 7 and 8 also part of Lot 6 BEG AT PT 150 FT S & 145.5 FT E OF NE CORNER LOT 9 S SIDE 3RD ST ORIGINAL PLAN TH W 100.5 FT TH S TO 2ND ST. TH E TO RR R/W TH N ALG R/W TO POB ASSESSOR'S PLAT 2 ALSO PARCEL LAKE MICHIGAN BOTTOM LAND ADJ & CONT TO GOVT LOT 3 SEC 34 COM AT S $\frac{1}{4}$ COR TH S 89 DEG 33' E 732.8 FT TH N 3 DEG 57' E 173.15 FT FOR POB TH S 75 DEG 30' E 446 FT TH N 13 DEG 30' E 155 FT TH N 67 DEG 35' W 440 FT TH S 31 DEG 23' 53" W 225.31 FT TH S 75 DEG 30' E 58 FT TO POB ALSO ANY LAKE BOTTOM LAND LYING BETWEEN AND OPPOSITE ABOVE PAR & GOVT LOT 3 SEC 34 T32N R11W.

and the words "Northport Public Bathing Beach" will include "Lots 7 through 8 in Assessor's Plat 1 Village of Northport located on the East Side of Bay Street from the East Side of the Leelanau Transit Railroad Right-of-Way to Grand Traverse Bay".

Section 3. Supplementary Regulations

The Northport Village Council may from time to time adopt regulations supplementing this ordinance. These supplementary regulations shall be publicly posted at Haserot Park and the Northport Bathing Beach; the violation of which shall constitute a violation of this ordinance.

Section 4. Violation/Penalty

Any person, firm or corporation which violates any of the provisions of this ordinance or regulations, promulgated pursuant thereto, shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be punished by imprisonment for not more than ninety (90) days, or a fine of not more than Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00), or both.

Section 5. Severability

The provisions of this ordinance are hereby declared to be severable and if any clause, sentence, word, section or provision is declared void or unenforceable for any reason by any court of competent jurisdiction, it shall not affect any portion of the ordinance other than said part or portion thereof.

Section 6. Enforcement

The provisions of this ordinance shall be enforced by the Northport Police Department and/or the Leelanau County Sheriff's Department and/or the Michigan State Police.

Section 7. Effective Date

This ordinance shall take effect twenty (20) days after passage by the Village Council.
